

## Indoor Worship Information

For those of you intending to worship in person, inside the sanctuary, please see below for some helpful information before you arrive. **Please remember that you need to sign up for each service to make sure we have accommodations for all to attend. The link is in each Saturday's eblast.** The deadline is two days prior to the service (Friday for Sunday). This will be done on a first-come, first-served basis since we will have limited seating. **Please print out your own bulletins for any given service and bring it with you or bring a cell phone/tablet to follow along in the service,** to help us reduce what we need to print. A limited number of bulletins will be available. If you signed up but are not feeling well on the day of the service, per CDC guidelines, even if you have been vaccinated, please stay home for the safety of those in attendance.

### ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- Please park only in the **south parking lot** of the church which is the parking lot directly facing 106th Street.
- Use **either door that comes directly into the sanctuary** (those being the doors that are located just down from Fellowship Hall, or the doors that face the pre-school playground). **Do not use the Fellowship Hall doors or the main entrance door leading into the narthex.**
- Please **put on your mask upon exiting your car.** Masks must be worn properly fitting snugly and covering both the nose and mouth.
- The sidewalks leading up to the sanctuary doors are marked with blue tape for the **proper social distancing** between families/individuals. Please maintain a 6-foot distance from other households at all times.
- **You'll be greeted at the doors to be signed in,** to apply hand sanitizer, receive a mask if needed, to double mask if you elect, receive a bulletin if needed, and to pick up individual pre-packaged communion sets, with a choice of wine or grape juice with wafers. Upon exiting the service, please take the empty containers with you and discard them in the waste baskets located at the exit doors.
- **The ushers will seat you according to the number of folks in your immediate family.** Please understand that the sanctuary has been marked off to be properly socially distanced, and therefore you might not be in the same seat or even in the same area where you have been accustomed to sitting.
- **We will be watching the live stream service from the parking lot on the two large screens in the sanctuary.** The guest organist will be playing the organ in the balcony. The hymns will be printed out in the bulletins, so please follow along, but **do not sing the hymns out loud,** but rather sing them to yourselves. The singing may change in the future, but as of now, it is recommended that we not sing indoors. We will participate in the congregational responses but ask that you speak softly and quietly.
- **At the conclusion of the service, the ushers will dismiss the congregation row by row.** Please remain seated until you have been asked to stand and exit. Offerings will be received as you exit the sanctuary. Please don't gather in the sanctuary after the service but depart immediately to the parking lot where you

can safely greet other members by socially distancing and keeping your masks on.
